Changing Home Page Video on Auto Group Website

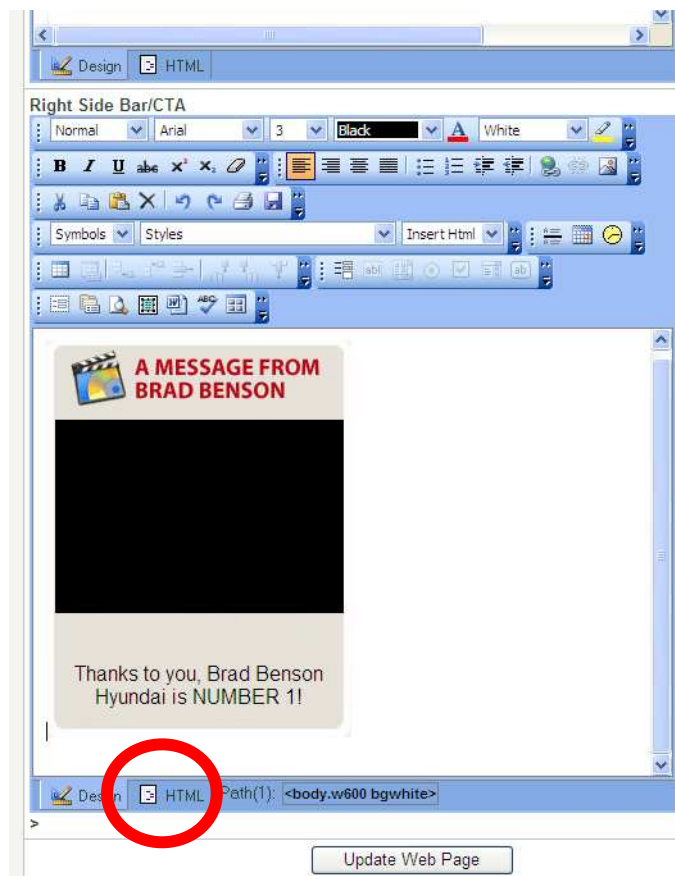
Steps

1. Upload video to video sharing site such as, "YouTube".
2. Copy, "Embed Code" onto clipboard

3. Go to administrative area for website (Auto Group, Hyundai, Mitsubishi or Used Cars), select, "Single Page CMS" and select, "Default.aspx".
 - a. Once you are viewing the selected page locate the, "Right side Bar/CTA" editor window.
 - b. Select, HTML" tab at bottom of window.



4. Paste Embed code from You Tube into window in between the code that reads, “<!-- Put Video Clip Code Below please make video width="225" height="151" -->” and, “<!-- End of Video Clip Code -->”. Be sure to delete the current video code between these two items currently.
 - a. NOTE: Be sure you do not change the comment code. The “<>” brackets must remain in place.



5. The size parameters in the embed code must be changed in two spots.

6. Adjust size to width="225" height="151".
7. Click "update web page" when completed.
